Welcome

Welcome to the 2019 **Texas Lunker Challenge** presented by **Mossy Oak Elements**! This event is the first stop of the 2019 Bass Pro Shops Collegiate Bass Fishing Series and will consist of one weigh-in, overall big bass format. Make sure to register **ONLINE** before the cutoff date of Monday, January 28th. Get ready to fish on one of the hottest Texas fisheries around and compete in the 2019 Bass Pro Shops Collegiate Bass Fishing Series!

Tournament Format

- One-day, individual big bass tournament.
- Up to three (3) contestants may fish from the same boat. Contestants are not required to be members of the same collegiate fishing team / school to fish together in the same boat.
- Permission must be granted by the Tournament Director in order for any angler to fish alone. The Tournament Director may assign a non-fishing observer to accompany any angler fishing alone.
- Prizes will be awarded for the top forty (40) heaviest bass weighed.
- This event will count for Bass Pro Shops School of the Year points and will be awarded to the top two (2) anglers from each school.
- Off-limits will take place Monday, Jan. 28th through Thursday, Jan. 31st.
- Official practice days will be Friday, Feb. 1st & Saturday, Feb. 2nd.
- Angler Check-in/Pre-tournament meeting will be held on Saturday, Feb. 2nd at 5pm. Anglers must be off the water by 3pm, unless they are fishing the Texas Team Trail event. Those fishing the TXTT event must be off the water after they have weighed-in.


