See you at Lake Dardanelle!






TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Each Angler must read and abide by the official <u>AFTCO Open Rules</u>.







Two-day, team tournament. A team consists of two-anglers fishing from the same boat.

The first official practice day will be Monday October 5, 2020.



Winners will be determined by the heaviest accumulated two-day weight per team. School of the Year points will be awarded to the top two (2) teams from each school.



All school clubs are allowed to register as many teams as they want.

Permission must be granted by the Tournament Director in order for any angler to fish alone.



SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

October 5th – 9th Official Practice Days

- October 5-8, Monday-Thursday: Official practice safe light to sundown.
- <u>October 9, Friday</u>: Final official practice day from safe light to **3:00pm**.

October 9th Mandatory Angler Check-in & Meeting

- 6:00pm Greeting & Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting: due to local requirements to maintain safe distancing, Meeting will take place via ZOOM.
- Link will be emailed & texted to each registered angler.
- All anglers must submit completed waivers electronically prior to meeting. Please visit our website for <u>forms and details</u>.
- No meal will be served.

October 10th – 11th Tournament Days

- Location: Lake Dardanelle State Park
- Take-off: Begins at Safe Light
- Weigh-in: Begins 3pm on Day 1; 2pm on Day 2
- Angler Meal provided To-Go during Weigh-in
- Awards following Day 2 weigh-in

ANGLER GRAB BAGS

Grab bags with snacks & waters will be handed out at Launch / Take-Off on Day 1.





Take-off and Weigh-in will be at Lake Dardanelle State Park each tournament day – October 10-11.


Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be implementing safety protocols throughout the event in order to best protect our anglers, staff, and host community.

Please follow all posted guidelines and instructions on-site at the event.


