REGISTER

Two-day. individual big bass tournament.

You can weigh-in fish every session, but vou can't have more than two (2) fish in the livewell per angler at anytime.

Up to 3 anglers can fish in every boat.

There will be seven (7) weigh-in sessions over the two-day

WEIGH-IN

Special Lure Rules:

All contestants must use Berklev baits EXCLUSIVELY during this event on Day 2.

Complete details can be found in the rules.

School of the Year points will be awarded to the top two (2) bass weighed by each school, according to SOY rules.

Even if a fish doesn't qualify for SOY points it can still win prizes.

Monday, March 8th – Thursday, March 11th

- Official Practice Days.
- Registered anglers are allowed to practice from safe light to sundown.
- Anglers must abide by all tournament and safety rules throughout practice and tournament days.



Friday, March 12th

- Official Practice Day.
- Registered anglers are allowed to practice from safe light to 3:00pm.
- Anglers must submit paperwork via the ACA website or email. Details will be emailed to anglers.
- 6:00pm: Greeting & Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting via ZOOM. Link will be emailed &/or texted to each registered angler.

Saturday, March 13th – Sunday, March 14th

- Tournament Days.
- A controlled release will begin at safe light.
- Day 1 sessions will close at 9am, 11am, 1pm, and 3pm.
- Day 2 sessions will close at 9:30am, 11:30am, and 1:30pm.
- To-Go Meal served to anglers & Prizes presented after the last weigh-in session on each tournament day.



Plans for the pre-tournament meeting are subject to change based on local safety ordinances due to Covid-19.

MANDATORY ANGLER PAPERWORK

All anglers must turn in the required paperwork via the ACA website or email. Registered anglers will receive an email with instructions.

PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING

Due to expected COVID restrictions, this event's mandatory meeting will be held via ZOOM. A link and instructions will be texted to registered anglers.

ANGLER GRAB BAGS

Grab bags with snacks, waters, and a few gifts from our partners will be given out at Launch / Take-Off on Day 1.











Take-off and Weigh-in will be at Paris Landing State Park on tournament days – March 13th & March 14th.

There will be no parking/launch charge during the days of the event. Get your parking pass for the week when you first arrive at Paris Landing.



A valid Tennessee fishing license is required for each angler.

Anglers should launch at Paris Landing State Park tournament days!


WEIGH-IN SESSIONS

The weigh-in sessions times for the 2021 Bass Pro Shops Big Bass Bash presented by Berkley will be as follows:



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be implementing safety protocols throughout the event in order to best protect our anglers, staff, and host community.

If any angler has been sick or traveled out of the country during the two weeks prior to this event, ACA requests that they do not participate in this events.

Please follow all posted guidelines and instructions on-site at the event.

Staff and anglers will be required to wear buffs, masks, gloves, etc. when interacting with each other and anytime interacting with anyone when a safe distance of 6 feet or more cannot be achieved.

Only spectators traveling with anglers / bass fishing clubs will be allowed; there will be a designated area for these spectators in order to provide safe distancing.

BERKLEY ONLY LURES - DAY 2 BIG BASS

During Day two of the Big Bass Bash only artificial Berkley Baits, including hard baits, may be used. Please refer to "Special Lure Rules" below as well as in the Official Tournament Rules.

All contestants must use Berkley baits EXCLUSIVELY during this event on Day 2. The complete line up may be viewed at www.purefishing.com/our-brands/



Spinner bait frames, jig heads, buzz bait frames, etc. may be used when paired with Berkley products as trailers. To clarify, anglers may use other brands jigs and spinner-baits, but those baits must have a Berkley trailer on them.

All terminal tackle (Alabama Rig Style) must include a "functional" Berkley soft plastic.

Non-Berkley skirts and soft plastic trailers are NOT permitted at any time.
