Capital City Lake Murray Country This year marks the 16th year of the Association of Collegiate Anglers' BoatUS Collegiate Bass Fishing Championship presented by Bass Pro Shops! We are excited to be bringing this event to Lake Murray, the Jewel of South Carolina, for the first time ever – anglers will be more than welcomed by the Capital City Lake Murray Country community and the fishing will be great!

On May 26 & 27, 2021, 200 of the top collegiate anglers in the country will be competing in this no entry fee event and will take home thousands of dollars in prizes and double points towards the coveted Bass Pro Shops School of the Year presented by Abu Garcia race. After we crown this year's National Champions, the next School of the Year will be crowned as well!

Be sure to check the qualification rules and register ON-LINE before the cutoff date of Friday, May 7th.

While we look forward to seeing you all at Lake Murray, please be assured that everyone's health and safety during this continued COVID-19 pandemic is our priority – we will have safety protocols in place that adhere to local and CDC guidelines so make sure and monitor communications about those procedures.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT Each Angler must read and abide by the official <u>Championship Rules</u>.

Registration closes Friday, May 7, 2021 at 6:00pm.

Two-day, team tournament. A team consists of two-anglers fishing from the same boat.

Off-limits begins on Monday, May 10, 2021 at 12:00am local time. The first official practice day will be Saturday, May 22, 2021 at safe light.

All school clubs qualify to register one (1) two-angler team for the Championship. Schools may qualify to send additional teams by competing in ACA events, being in Top 25 for School of the Year, or being a past Champion. **Read complete Qualification Criteria** here.

Permission must be granted by the Tournament Director in order for any angler to fish alone.

Winners will be determined by the heaviest accumulated weight per team. The two highest finishing teams for each college/university will both earn Bass Pro Shops School of the Year presented by Abu Garcia points.



SAFE DISTANCING PROCEDURES

Throughout the Championship event, the ACA will be following safe distancing procedures implemented for the protection of our anglers, partners, and staff. Please be mindful of these procedures and know that we are helping keep communities healthy by following guidelines set forth by the State of South Carolina and the CDC.

Anglers should not participate in the tournament if they have had any of these symptoms in the past 14-days: Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, Loss of taste or smell, Diarrhea, Feeling feverish or a measured temperature > 99.9 degrees, or Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19.


- Check-in & Banquet will occur at Dreher Island State Park and procedures will be in place for social distancing and submitting paperwork electronically beforehand.
- "Swag Bags" will be handed out to anglers that will include snacks, waters, and products from our partners.
- To-Go Meals will be provided to anglers as feasible.
- Anglers will be encouraged to not congregate in large groups at events, boat ramp or along the docks; face coverings will be required.
- If persons are there to cheer on their favorite anglers, they must wear face coverings, stay within their group, remain in designated spectator areas, as well as keep a minimum of 6-feet from others.
