Tournament Morning Registration: You may register at the boat ramp from 5:30am-6:30am tournament morning and pay with either cash or venmo.

Rules:

- The decisions of the judges and event officials shall be final in all matters.
- Safety- Safe boat conduct must be observed at all times. A Coast Guard approved life preserver must be worn when the gas motor is running. - The life preserver must be strapped, zipped or snapped securely. Kill switches must be operational and attached to the boat and driver whenever the gas motor is in use. All local, state, federal and Game & Fish regulations shall apply and must be observed during tournament hours.
Tournament boats may be inspected by tournament officials at any time.
- Sportsmanship- Follow the Golden Rule. Competitors are expected to follow high levels of sportsmanship.
- Boat and Motor All boats must have required Coast Guard safety equipment as well as an operational aerator and live-well. No stringers at any time.
 - Official Checkpoint - Will be the site of the take-off and weigh-in.
- Scoring: Bass include - Largemouth, smallmouth, spotted bass will score. All Bass must be 15" or longer.
 - Dead Fish – Dead fish will be counted, minus one (1) pound penalty.
- Late penalty- for every minute after tournament hours there will be a one minute penalty
 - Polygraph - Test may be administered to any contestant at the discretion of the tournament committee
- Protests: all protests must be submitted in writing to the tournament director within 15 minutes of weigh in completion. Tournament director's decision is final on all matters
- You may not fish within the mouth of the cove the tournament launches from
